

KRUISIN' KITTITAS 2018: BURNOUT RULES CAR# _____

ALL BURNOUT VEHICLES & ENTRIES MUST BE STREET LEGAL, HAVE VALID ID, MIN. INSURANCE COVERAGE, HAVE A DRIVE SHAFT LOOP INSTALLED AND PASS A SAFETY INSPECTION

1. CONTESTANTS MUST PRE-REGISTER BEFORE 1:45PM (ENTRY FEE IS \$15.00 PER VEHICLE), SIGN A LIABILITY WAIVER AND FILL OUT AN ANNOUNCING CARD. **ONLY AFTER YOU HAVE TURNED THIS INFO IN WILL YOU RECEIVE YOUR CONTESTANT NUMBER VALIDATING ENTRY.**
2. A VALID **DRIVERS LICENSE** IS REQUIRED AND **MINIMUM INSURANCE COVERAGE** REQUIRED BY WASHINGTON STATE LAW FOR EACH OF THE VEHICLE(S) ENTERED. MINIMUM AGE TO PARTICPATE IS 18 YEARS.
3. EACH VEHICLE MUST PASS A SIMPLE SAFETY INSPECTION BEFORE PARTICIPATING (LUG NUTS, LOOSE PARTS, ETC) IF FOR ANY REASON A SAFETY OFFICIAL DEEMS THE VEHICLE UNSAFE THE VEHICLE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE. **ALL VEHICLES MUST HAVE A DRIVE SHAFT LOOP INSTALLED.**
4. EACH CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOWED TO BURNOUT **ONLY ONE TIME**, NO PRACTICE RUNS.
5. FOR THIS SLOW ROLLING BURNOUT, NO STANDING STILL. THE AMOUNT OF SMOKE AND LENGTH OF BLACK MARKS LEFT WILL DETERMINE THE WINNNER. There are 3 classes of which a 1st place winner will be picked: Pro Class (previous winner & challengers) Amateur Class and Truck Class.
6. THE CONTESTANT WILL TRAVEL A PRE-DETERMINED LENGTH IN THE DESIGNATED AREA AND **IMMEDIATELY STOP ACCELERATING WHEN SAFETY OFFICIALS FLAG YOU TO STOP (A BUZZER/LIGHT WILL BE PLACED INSIDE YOUR VEHICLE TO NOTIFY YOU WHEN TO STOP, A BLOW HORN WILL SOUND AS WELL).**
7. THE VEHICLE MUST STAY TO THE RIGHT OF THE DOUBLE YELLOW LINE. IF YOUR VEHICLE CROSSES THE LINE OR BEGINS TO TURN TOWARD THE LEFT OR RIGHT TO AN EXTREME THAT THE OFFICIAL FEELS IS UNSAFE TO THE CROWD, YOU WILL BE FLAGGED TO STOP ACCELERATION. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.
8. THE STREET WILL BE CLOSED SO THAT VEHICLES CAN BE LINED UP BY CLASS ENTERED AT THE STARTING POINT. THERE YOU WILL RECEIVE INSTRUCTION AND SAFETY INSPECTION.
9. ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST FOLLOW THE DIRECTION OF THE SAFETY OFFICIALS AT ALL TIMES. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.

Agreement and Indemnity (Hold Harmless Agreement)

THIS AGREEMENT made on _____ (date) by and between _____ (print name) Indemnitor, and the supporters of the Kruisin' Kittitas Car Show & Burnouts, The City of Kittitas and the Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce Indemnatee.

Whereas, the parties have agreed and herein agree that they entered and entered into that certain transaction, in consideration of their mutual promises and for their mutual benefit described as "the burnout event" at the Kruisin' Kittitas Car Show, August 11TH 2018. And this agreement is a part thereof whether by modification or memorialization.

Now, therefore, the parties additionally agree and warrant that with reference to said transaction, Indemnitor, for himself and binding his assignees, heirs, executors and successors, shall indemnify and hold harmless and Indemnatee his assignees, heirs, executors and successors, from any and all loss, injury, expense damage, claim, legal action, transfer and liability, including attorney's fees, that may arise out of or due to the aforementioned transaction and Indemnitor agrees to defend Indemnatee against such. This Indemnification clause applied to the parties themselves as well as to third parties, whether claiming under a party or independently against a party.
